- Will work creatively across the benefice to shape a shared vision while honouring each parish's identity.
- Is resilient and hopeful in the face of financial and structural challenges and committed to building sustainable ministry.
- Embodies the diocesan values of generous faith, courageous hope, and life-giving love.
