We are a group of four villages in the beautiful Weald of Kent. The Benefice was formed in 2007 and we have had two incumbents since then. We have grown closer together over the years through cooperation and friendship. The total population of our Benefice is approximately 10,000, and there is a good social and age mix. There are two larger villages (Headcorn and Sutton Valence) and two smaller ones (Chart Sutton and East Sutton). There are three schools in the Benefice – Headcorn Primary School, Sutton Valence Primary School and Sutton Valence School, an all-age public school with its own chaplain.

### **ADMINISTRATOR**

We have an Administrator who works for 12 hours per week for the Benefice, mainly from home, but also from an office in Headcorn Church Vestry. The Benefice Ministry Rota is coordinated by the Incumbent with one of our churchwardens. Each rota covers a period of four months. A typical Benefice Ministry Rota is included as an Appendix.

### MINISTRY SUPPORT

There is a good group of active retired clergy in the Deanery, who are very willing to lead worship in our Benefice when asked. There is also a Lay Ministry Group, all eight of whom are involved with non-eucharistic worship leading. We have one member of our congregation in his first year of training as a Licensed Lay Minister.

### **BENEFICE SERVICES**

Every fifth Sunday we come together for a Benefice Service at one of our churches in rotation.

#### **CHURCHWARDENS**

The six churchwardens are in frequent touch with each other and have regular meetings to discuss Benefice matters.

### THE VICARAGE

The Vicarage is situated in Oak Lane, Headcorn, towards the eastern end of the village. It was purchased and converted for use as a vicarage about twenty years ago, and is a pleasant, modern four-bedroom detached house, with a reasonable sized garden and good parking facilities.
