#### PERSON SPECIFICATION

E = essential and D = desirable

#### 1) QUALIFICATIONS / TRAINING

Applicants for the post should:

- a) Be an Anglican priest (or priest from a Church in communion with the Church of England) with experience at incumbent level (E)
- b) Fluency in both written and spoken English, preferably as a first language (E)
- c) Experience in a wide range of diverse ethnic and cultural groups (D)
- d) Training or experience in interfaith relations / a sensitivity in interfaith relations, especially with Islamic culture and life. (D)

#### 2) EXPERIENCE

Candidates equipped for the role will be able to demonstrate experience and understanding in the following areas

- a) Living in North Africa and having an understanding and appreciation of both the joys and complexities of living abroad (D)
- b) An understanding of the region and culture in which our church is located (E)
- c) Proven ability to take on 'non worship' based tasks such as meetings with local leaders, authorities and other key local stakeholders (E)

#### 3) KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

Candidates will be able to demonstrate that they possess knowledge, skills and competencies as follows:

- a) Empathy and understanding towards a diverse congregation, spanning several and varying cultural and socioeconomic groups (E)
- b) An understanding of, and willingness to enhance, a modern catholic spirituality for our eucharistically centred community(E)
- c) Some proficiency in French or Spanish language, or a willingness to learn one of them. (D)

#### 4) GENERAL ATTRIBUTES

- a) Strong communication skills, including working with computers / online communication (E)
- b) Strong leadership skills and a willingness to work collaboratively / team building (E)
